Day 1 Tuesday 25th June

- 5:00AM drop off and depart from school at 5:30AM— please ensure your Passport is readily available as these will be securely looked after by a member of staff until they are required at border checks.
- 10:05AM check in at P&O Terminal, Dover, 12:05PM depart
- 14:35 Arrive at Calais (local time) ETA at the Ypres Lodge 17:00
- 18:00 Dinner
- 19:00 Coach out for a team building bowling session
- 21:00 Back at the hotel
- 22:00 lights out

Day 2 Wednesday 26th June Ypres - Passchendaele

- 07:00 wake up call for an 08:00 continental breakfast
- 08:45 Group briefing then board coach at 09:00
- Lijssenthoek British Cemetery and Visitors Centre 2nd largest British military cemetery in the world and site of military hospitals during WW1
- Langemark German Cemetery. Contrast how the fallen soldiers on each side have been remembered
- Lunch eat packed lunch picked up from the Lodge
- 12:30 Memorial Museum Passchendaele 1917 includes unique DUGOUT and TRENCH experience
- Tyne Cot British Cemetery. Largest British military cemetery in the world built in the area where the Battle of Passchendaele was fought in 1917.
- **16:00 Ypres Centre some free time** and a visit to St Georges Church dedicated to perpetual remembrance unique and often overlooked.
- 17:00 Two course meal at a restaurant in Ypres centre.
- 18:45 group visit to Leonidas Chocolaterie chance to buy some Belgian chocolate!
- 19:30 Walk to the **Menin Gate area** to take part in the Memorial service
- 20:30 Back at the hotel
- 10-10.30 lights out

Day 3 Thursday 27th June - Somme

- 07:00 wake up call for 08:00 breakfast
- 09:00 check out everything on to the coach
- **Newfoundland Park-** preserved battlefield site of the Newfoundland's regiment 's failed attack on the first day of the Somme
- visit to the **Thiepval memorial** and visitor centre memorial to the missing of the Somme
- Lunch
- 15:00 depart for Calais for 17:25 check in
- 19:25 Depart Calais 19:55 arrive Dover (LT)
- 23:45 ETA school!

Equipment Checklist

- Passport

- Large bag for dirty clothes
- Hat/sun protection as we are outside for large amounts of the day
- <u>Water bottle</u> the Ypres Lodge is reducing single use plastic bottles and these will not be available. Students will be encouraged to fill up a reusable water bottle for each day. You may want to bring spares /other drinks with you.
- Rucksack
- Food for journey on 1st day
- Snacks for 3 days to supplement provided meals and the journey home
- Writing implements such as pens and pencils
- Pocket money for souvenirs/gifts/drink out at bowling (c.50 Euros)
- Some sterling to purchase food on the return journey during the day as we will have a packed lunch provided by the Lodge but will not arrive back at school until 23:45.
- Travel sickness tablets/bands as required

^{*}As the Battlefields of Ypres and the Somme can are very open and exposed areas it is vital that pupils bring layers of clothing, waterproof outer layers, and appropriate footwear.
