#### **Sad News**

It was with great sadness and with great difficulty that we wrote to you earlier this week to inform you of the death of a member of our school community.

Danny Smith passed away at the beginning of this week while he was on annual leave. This news has been very difficult for many of us to process, and our thoughts are with Danny's family, his friends. Danny has spent many years at KNSB and was very close to colleagues both old and new. As you can imagine this is a very difficult time for lots of people. Although Danny did not directly teach students, we were aware that his loss would still potentially affect them but following the whole school briefing that we delivered to everyone on Wednesday, we have been overwhelmed by the sensitivity of our boys, who have shown incredible maturity and emotional intelligence. Boys have checked in with one another, been asking staff how they are, and basically showcasing what makes KNSB such a special place.

We are grateful for your support in facilitating conversations about this at home. We have begun to organise some support sessions via our School Counsellor or mentoring appointments through our pastoral links for those that are struggling with this news. If you have concerns about your son and would like him to access additional support, then please can you let us know by contacting your son's form tutor or allocated pastoral link.

The details about Danny's funeral/memorial are not yet clear. However, please be aware that it is extremely likely that the school will be closed for either the morning, afternoon or day of the funeral to allow staff to join the family to remember and celebrate Danny's life.
