The Big Iftar III, Friday 27th February at Bartley Green Sailing Club

Ramadan 2026 begins during February half term. It is one of the five pillars of Islam. Ramadan is the time in which the Quran was revealed to the Prophet Muhammed (SAW). During the month of Ramadan, all Muslims are required to abstain from food and drink, from dawn until dusk. The act of fasting helps Muslims to feel closer to God and be compassionate for those in need; it also seen as a way to practise patience and avoid bad habits. The time to open each fast at sunset is called Iftar. Iftar will be announced by the Adhan (the call to prayer), and water and dates are usually the first things to eat as this is what was done in the time of the prophet. This will be followed by a meal after Maghrib prayer. It is a time for people to come together in unity, share a meal and reflect on their day.

It is in this spirit that King's Norton School for Boys invites all our community (regardless of faith) to The Big Iftar on Friday 27th February at 17.00. This year, it will be held at Bartley Green Sailing Club. Let us be together as a community and share a meal in solidarity.

This will be a ticketed event with a minimum donation of **£7.50 per ticket**. There are very limited places so if you would like to attend, please get tickets as soon as possible All proceeds will go towards putting on the event, and any excess contributions will go towards this year's KNSB charity, Ronald McDonald House, Birmingham.

- As soon as we have the 100 seats filled, the sale of tickets will close
