### KNSB Online

At King's Norton School for Boys, we appreciate that making the move to secondary school can be nerve-racking for parents and students alike, and we will be with you every step of the way to support a smooth and successful transition. We are very keen that you get to know us before your son arrives in September. ### Transition Day

We will be in touch with you in May to discuss your son's transition, and all students will participate in a full induction day on Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> July, followed by a Parents' Transition Presentation on that evening. There will also be bespoke visits for students with additional needs. During our various induction visits, students will have the chance to meet key staff at KNSB, as well as be involved in a tour of the school and participate in several lessons and activities to give them a taste of what is to come. They will also meet some of our current year 7 students and be able to ask any questions they may have about starting secondary school.

### Summer School

Following on from our hugely successful Summer School in recent years, we are delighted to inform you that there will once again be a two-day offer for all Year 6 students joining us in September. We want to share provisional information with you in advance as we know that many of you may be planning holidays during the summer break. So, while the planning is going on behind the scenes, this is what we can tell you so far:
